■ ■ Geof Hill: The Man behind the Camera - See How he makes Trix looks good!



Introducing Geof! He produced a DVD of Trix's Poem called *WAVES OF EMOTION* which will be released in this month.

BIO: Rarely does the world of film encounter an artistic genius of Geof Hill's caliber. Geof is one of the foremost leaders in photography and videography, sets the pace for the industry, and well deserves his worldwide following. He combines a natural eye for the rare, beautiful composition, with 23 years of experience in all facets of the media, to produce the breathtaking results that have become the legendary Geof Hill look.

Geof defied the impossible when he pioneered non-linear computer-based editing 12 years ago, and he continues to stay ahead of technology. As a cinematographer, his abilities have been sought by moviemakers, corporations, and heads of state. He was also Webmaster for the World Trade Center in New York. Geof's love affair with light and sound began in his teens, when he began doing remotes for a broadcast station in San Francisco, and worked as a highly sought-after DJ for weddings and such corporations as Coca-Cola, Sears, Home Depot and Fed Ex. He went on to engineer 75 albums, provide sound reinforcement for live concert venues, build sound systems for theatres, sell thousands of CDs, arrange stage lighting, and work in broadcasting with multi-track productions. He has created commercial sound tracks, promoted hip-hop artists with Atlantic Records, shot music videos for bands, produced countless corporate films, and remade for corporations, the movies, "Star Trek," "The Matrix," and "Charlie's Angels." His crew also documented a national BMX tour.

Since then, Geof has produced more than 200 historical pieces for the State of California's Parks and Recreation and the Women's Hall of Fame, seen by more than 20 million viewers. His work has also appeared on MTV and Cartoon Network. Geof's business acumen came in handy when he was offered a top administrative position for two years, in the largest chain of urgent care centers in the Bay Area. He was also the Network Engineer for Baskin Robbins Export Division, and developed their software to track inventory, profit and loss, translate and label. From this, he automated international distribution operations for Baskin-Robbins and Mrs. Fields cookies. He also speaks Korean.
